Tournament Format

The 8th Annual Ukraine Youth Cup Co-ed Soccer Tournament:

- 1) Open to all participants
- 2) 11-17 years of age - as of 1994
- 3) 5 games guaranteed
- 4) sanctioned referees
- 5) trophies for all players
- 6) team wear
- 7) sanctioned by Manitoba Soccer Association, supported by Winnipeg Youth Soccer Association and Manitoba Major Soccer League



TOURNAMENT RULES

All games to be played at Gateway Recreation Centre.

- Roster is limited to 15 players per team.
- 5 fielded players and a keeper on the pitch
- Teams will be awarded 3 points per win, 1 point per tie and 0. point per loss.
- Game length - 25 minute half
- A yellow card will be enforced with a one minute penalty.
- A red card will be enforced with a game suspension addressed by disciplinary committee.
- There is no slide tackling by any player.
- Tie Breaker Rules
 1. Number of Points (wins)
 2. (+-) Value (Greater)
 3. Goals against
 4. Head to head results
- A 7 goal "mercy rule" will be in effect during all round robin games in the Ukraine Youth Tournament 2010. The official finals score for the game will be recorded when the difference in goals between the two teams is 7 (ex. 7 - 0, 10 - 3, 14 - 7, etc.). The game will continue to be played in its entirety with no further goals being recorded. All rules of the game remain in effect until the game is over. Goal scorers will be recorded for stats purposes.
- For semi-final and final games in which a winner must be declared, two overtime periods of 5 minutes each shall be played. If there is no winner after the two overtime periods, kicks will be taken from the penalty centre.

WYSA Rule: The kicks shall be taken as a breakaway, 1 vs 1, with the shooter starting from the centre mark. Goalkeepers must be on their goal line at the start of the shoot-out, after that they can move but must remain in their penalty area.

Goalkeepers are allowed to come off their goal line once the shooter touches the ball. They must stay in their penalty area and can challenge for the ball as they would in normal play (slide tackle not permitted). The kicker must only move forward or side-ways with the ball. If the shot does not enter the goal or the goalkeeper prevents the ball from entering the goal, the shoot-out is over. If the ball strikes the goalkeeper and enters the goal, a goal will be awarded. There are no rebounds.

Brief History of the Ukraine Youth Cup

Soccer is a sport which is played by millions throughout the world. It is a sport that demands the most of an athlete of any age - endurance, speed, power, balance, agility and it creates friendship. This sport is a wonderful vehicle to meet new people from different cultures and to share each others values and experiences.

In 2003, a Ukrainian based soccer team under the name of the Winnipeg Dynamo Kyiv Soccer Club decided to get heavily involved in the Ukrainian community by hosting their 1st annual Ukraine Youth Cup Indoor Co-ed Soccer Tournament for boys and girls between the ages of 11 - 16. With the assistance of Nestor Budyk, Tara Maluzynsky and Peter J. Manastyrsky, this tournament became a success within the Ukrainian and soccer community. At the end of that inaugural tournament, it was decided to continue future soccer matches because of the cultural involvement by the parents and the appreciation by the participants. Many parents mentioned that the Ukraine Youth Cup Indoor Co-ed Soccer Tournament is a diplomatic vehicle to promote cultural diversity within our province.

This 2003 event encompassed 50 youth participants, parents and friends and the Ukrainian community. The tournament was endorsed under the auspices of Ukrainian Canadian Congress-Manitoba Provincial Council. This support and acknowledgement has given Winnipeg Dynamo Kyiv Soccer Club the mandate to promote Ukrainian sport involvement within a cultural setting. Also, that tournament in 2003 inspired and continues to ignite to this day, the Ukrainian community, the variety of professional people and the Ukrainian organizations to rally around the youth in a form of a tournament.

On March 27th & 28th, 2010, the 8th Annual Ukraine Youth Cup Indoor Co-ed Soccer Tournament will take place with 90 youth participants, six co-ed teams with names such as Lviv, Kyiv, Poltava, Odesa, Donetsk and Chernivsti representing the different major cities of Ukraine. This tournament is OPEN TO ALL participants beyond the Ukrainian Community. The Ukraine Youth Cup Indoor Co-ed Soccer Tournament is sanctioned by Manitoba Soccer Association, Winnipeg Youth Soccer Association and Manitoba Major Soccer league which Winnipeg Dynamo Soccer Club is a member. It is a round-robin competition in which each team is guaranteed 5 games; awards are given out to all participants, team t-shirts and other donated items are provided by sponsoring businesses. In addition, referees from the Manitoba Soccer Referee Association will be officiating the matches.

Soccer is an enjoyable sport which is played by youth and its purpose is to teach skills, tactics and love for the game. This concept applies to the youth that are of Ukrainian ancestral background by having them express the enjoyment in a game of tournament soccer. By meeting other participants and sharing each others values, every player will create a strong presence and a long-lasting friendship over that weekend.
