

## WSEU YOUTH TO SENIOR POLICY

Due to “abuse of privilege” over the years, WSEU will adopt the following procedures for allowing youth players to play in Senior games as guest players.

1. Only a member of the Executive of WSEU will be allowed to issue, and sign, Youth to Senior permits to coaches. Note: The member of the Executive of WSEU must have approval from either the Director of Premier, the Director of Recreation or the Club Head Coach before signing.
2. Written permission from the player’s parent is required (e-mail acceptable)
3. Requests require 72 hours’ notice to the office to allow for proper permission and signatures
4. Senior club must have a certified CPIC team official on the rostered game sheet and must present with the youth player at all times
5. Coaches **must** bring proper identification of the player(s) requesting the permit(s). Roster forms or ID Cards will suffice.
6. Youth players **must** play with their Youth team before playing with a Senior Club
7. Any Youth player found registering with a Youth team for the sole purpose of playing up with a Senior Club, will be suspended from that Youth team indefinitely
8. The Youth Player card must be returned to his or her coach within 24 hours of Senior game in which he or she played.
9. Any Youth Coach found allowing Youth players to play Senior games without permission from the above mentioned Directors, will be suspended for **two years**
10. Any Senior Club found having Youth players as guests without our approval will have any future WSEU permits denied for a period of **two years**.
11. WSEU will work with **all Senior Leagues** in regards to this Policy and will expect that all permits used by WSEU players be returned to the WSEU Office after use.
