

WSEU Volunteer Policy

Every player registered in the Premier/Developmental Program is subject to the WSEU Volunteer Policy which requires a 2 hours contribution of volunteer time to the Winnipeg South End United Soccer Club. A \$50 volunteer surcharge will be assessed to each player at the time of registration. Players may choose to opt for this surcharge to be refundable or non refundable. If the non refundable surcharge option is chosen, this indicates that the player's family has opted to pay rather than to volunteer their time. This allows WSEU to utilize these funds to hire assistants as needed. When the refundable surcharge option is chosen, this indicates that the player's family intends to provide the 2 hours of volunteer time to the Club. When the volunteer time is completed, the \$50 surcharge will be credited back to the player.

In most cases, the two hour volunteer requirement needs to be served by a responsible adult over the age of 18. This person does not need to be related to the player, but clearly needs to indicate the player on whose behalf they are volunteering when signing in. In some cases, players themselves or others under the age of 18 may be able to provide the volunteer time depending on the duties required.

A list of volunteer needs will be provided prior to the start of the season to allow volunteers to sign up for their volunteer time.

Team officials (coaches and managers) who are on an official WSEU Premier or Developmental team roster, directors of the WSEU board, WSEU coordinators and WSEU soccer convenors are all considered to have fulfilled their volunteer requirement to the Winnipeg South End United Soccer Club.

Team officials who are on recreational team rosters are subject to the volunteer requirement as they are considered to be volunteering their time for their own community club rather than WSEU. Parents who serve as bench parents, linespersons, referee liaisons, etc. are also still subject to the volunteer requirement as this service, while of great importance, is deemed to be providing volunteer time to the individual team rather than the WSEU Club in its operations.
